_____ Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander (A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa or other Pacific Islands)

_____ White (A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East, or North Africa. Example: Spanish – A person having origins in any of the peoples of Spain. Middle Eastern – A person having origins in any of the peoples of Egypt, Israel, Iraq, Jordan, Lebanon, Palestine, Syria or Turkey)
