



# Family Rewards Program Information & Guidelines

The HFE Bucks Family Rewards Program is an exciting opportunity to accumulate credit toward enrollment fees. Families who use HFE Bucks can potentially reduce their enrollment fees each year by shopping at participating merchants.

The rebate earned by HFE Home & School will be shared with the families. Home & School will retain 50% of the rebates and give 50% of the rebates to HFE/TMP families in the form of enrollment fee credit.

## **EXAMPLE:**

Family buys a \$10 Taco Shop card which has 30% (\$3.00) rebate.  
\$1.50 will stay with HFE  
\$1.50 will go in your Family Rewards

## **EARNINGS PERIOD:**

March 26, 2018 – June 30, 2018 - Family Rewards earned will be applied to 2018-2019 school year.  
July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019 - Family Rewards earned will be applied to 2019-2020 school year.

## **GUIDELINES**

1. Families can increase their family rewards to 60% by using PrestoPay fifteen times.
  - Family must notify HFE Bucks coordinator at [hfebucks@gmail.com](mailto:hfebucks@gmail.com) once they reach this goal. The coordinator will then confirm the criteria has been met and increase the rewards percentage.
2. Family & friends may participate in the HFE Bucks program and help reduce a family's enrollment fees.
  - Sponsors complete [Sponsorship Form](#) and email to [hfebucks@gmail.com](mailto:hfebucks@gmail.com).
  - Sponsors can share their rewards with up to five families.
    - Example: Grandma Ann has three children that all send their kids to HFE/TMP. Grandma Ann can split her rewards between her three children's family rewards.
3. Families may have up to five different contributors to their family rewards.
  - Example: John & Jane Doe Family Rewards
    - Contributor #1 – John & Jane (Family is it's own first contributor)
    - Contributor #2 - John's personal business
    - Contributor #3 – Grandma Pat
    - Contributor #4 – Aunt Lulu
    - Contributor #5 – Ellen (Jane's friend)
4. Family Rewards cannot be carried over. If your rewards amount is greater than your enrollment fees, the extra amount will be distributed to the HFE General Fund.
