<b>Back-to-School Bash Committee</b> - Volunteers assist with the Back-to-School Bash before school starts, including helping the chairpersons with event setup, games and providing food. (August)
<b>Snack &amp; Bake/Staff Appreciation Committee</b> – Volunteers assist with recognition events for staff and prepare snack foods or baked goods for schoolwide events as needed throughout the year. (All Year)
<b>Chili Supper Sub-Committee Chairpersons</b> – Volunteers will be <b>chairpersons</b> for chili supper sub-committees, i.e. running the Game Room committee, Raffle committee, Silent Auction committee, Bingo room, Book Fair, Kitchen committee, Dining Room committee, Serving Line, Take-Out Line, or Dessert committee. (January)
<b>Family Support Committee</b> - Members provide meals for families during times of joy and sorrow. Notices are sent out to the committee and those who can help sign up as they are able. (All Year)
<b>Green School Committee</b> – Volunteers help implement "green school" programs, new environmental projects and ideas, recycling program, and educational activities and resources. (All Year)
<b>HFE Bucks/Box-Tops Committee</b> – Volunteers promote the collection of Box-Tops for Education. Volunteers maintain the HFE Bucks inventory and promote sales throughout the year. (All Year)
<b>Lead Parent Program</b> – Volunteers are the primary parent contact for classroom activities. One or two parents are selected for each classroom. Responsible for assisting/planning and organizing classroom events, snacks, field trips, etc. Will help answer questions for new families in the class. Will work with classroom teachers to assist with tasks for the classroom as needed. Communicate with other classroom parents via e-mail as needed. (All Year)
<b>Lunch Room Volunteers</b> - Members assist the lunchroom staff in serving meals each day in the serving line. Signup links are developed online for each month, sent to the committee & you can choose dates that work for you. (All Year)
<b>Mary's Baby Shower Committee</b> - Volunteers help set up the day of the shower, serve at the event and/or oversee clean-up. Members help deliver the gifts & donations to Catholic Charities. (December)
<b>Playground Committee</b> – Volunteers ensure that HFE/IHM playground facilities are up to code, oversee equipment inspections, recommend improvements, & assist in the handling of safety and security concerns related to the playground. Members are contacted on an as-needed basis & there is a playground cleanup date in August. (All Year)
<b>Race for Education Fundraiser</b> - Volunteers assist in preparing for or running the Race for Education in the spring, which can include putting together family packets, completing and sending mailers, recording donations, and/or helping tally lap cards at school on race day. (March/April)
<b>Red Wheel Fundraiser</b> – Volunteers assist on delivery day by bagging up family orders, totaling orders, and cleaning up. Volunteers help distribute orders to families on food pick-up day. (September/October)
<b>School Yearbook Committee</b> – Volunteers will help take photos of the class during special activities/events throughout the year and produce a school yearbook page, as well as help promote school events as needed. (All Year)
<b>School Mass Security Committee</b> – Volunteers will secure the church doors at the HFE school masses at IHM, allow in latecomers, monitor the gathering space & help supervise students who may come out to use the restroom. (All Year)
<b>Uniform/Dress Code Committee</b> - Volunteers will attend meetings to provide input on school uniforms and oversee uniform replacement. Volunteers will organize donated uniforms in the summer, set up and run a used uniform sale each summer. (All Year)
