Spirit Shirts & Uniforms

Spirit shirts cost \$10 per short-sleeve & \$15 per long-sleeve. Parents will need to place orders for all spirit/preschool shirts & used uniforms at enrollment day. There will **NOT** be a chance to order these items at a later date - thanks for noting this! HFE uniform vendors include SchoolBelles and Gone Logo. Parker uniforms in good condition may still be worn for the 19-20 year.

Walmart & JCPenney's are no longer vendors for our school and **will not be accepted** starting the 19-20 year.

You can contact SchoolBelles or Gone Logo during the school year if you need to update your child's attire.

Enrollment

- Completed Safe Environment Training (if volunteering/driving – this is good for 5 years)
- Health Insurance Card/Info
- Multiple blank checks and/or cash
- Doctor/dentist/emergency contact info
- Copy of child's birth & baptismal certificate (if new student/preschool)
- Financial info needed for Free & Reduced meal applications (if applying)

****DIGITAL AGAIN!****

You'll need to bring all of your printed & completed enrollment forms from our school website. You will start at the first table to receive your family fliers & child's new classroom.

You'll rotate around the tables, (i.e. Home & School, Preschool, After School Care, Spirit Shirts, Cafeteria), and end up at the Payment tables where a staff member will total up your enrollment receipt, collect your payment & paperwork. If you're needing to set up a payment plan, you will need to stop at the first payment table where the office staff are seated.

You **cannot** enroll unless you are cleared with your parish, attended the State of Catholic Schools Mtg, and completed the school stewardship form.

Enrollment is **mandatory to attend and cannot be done earlier than this date.

School Fees

Registration Fee: **TBA early June!** (family cap **TBA!**)

Your \$100 deposit per HFE student will be applied toward this fee for KP-6th graders)

Home & School Fee: \$10/family

ASC Registration Fee: \$25/child (including HFE/TMP staff's kids)

Spirit Shirt: \$10/short-sleeve, \$15/long-sleeve (you only have to order if needed – students wear these every Wednesday)

Yearbook: \$10/per book, optional (you will receive each yearbook at the following year's enrollment)

Preschool Fee: \$230/month (the Sept. fee is due at enrollment – you can also pay the whole year or by semester if you choose)

Tuition: applies to tuition families only, see more below!

Meals: you choose the amount to put in each child's lunch account, preferably a month's worth, see more below!

**If you set up a payment plan, school fees will be due in full by March 1st of the school year.*

A preschool student does not require a registration fee, tuition fee or meal payments!

Preschool Attire

Preschool wears the same grey spirit shirts like the rest of the school on Wednesdays. On Mon, Tues & Thurs, preschoolers wear a navy HFE preschool tee. Both are \$10 short-sleeve & \$15 long-sleeve. Sweatshirts are available: a crew neck for \$20 & a hoodie for \$25. Bottoms should be mostly solid: blues, grey, white, black, browns – these do not have to be a certain brand. Shoes must always be closed-toed. Socks & accessories follow our Uniform Policy (available in handbook on the school website). *All preschool tops must be ordered at enrollment! There is not another chance to order later on!

Tuition

For our families who are Non-Catholic, or Catholic but not registered at a Heartland Parish, a tuition payment will be due at the middle of each month. For both Non-Catholic families and Catholic Non-Registered families, the fee is \$4,500 per year per child, or \$450 per month for 10 months.

Bills will be sent out at the beginning of each month in your child's bookbag. Heartland Parishes include: IHM, St. Joseph, St. Nicholas, Comeau Campus Center, Our Lady Help of Christians (Antonino), St. Anthony (Schoenchen), St. Catherine (Catherine), and St. Francis (Munjour).

Meals

Meal prices are adjusted mid-summer, but will *not* have an increase higher than \$.05-.10 from the previous school year. We will note the new fees on the website & have a handy payment chart available at enrollment. During the 18-19 year, the totals were \$1.25 for breakfast, \$2.55 for KP-5th grade lunch, \$2.65 for 6th grade & \$.40 for extra milk. Extra milk is only available for students in 3rd-6th grade.

"A la Carte" cookies cost \$.25 each and are available to students in 4th-6th grade; students must simply bring a quarter with them in line when they would like one.

An application for Free & Reduced meals will be included in each family's enrollment packet. We strongly encourage our families to apply as quickly as possible, as it is beneficial to you & to our school through reimbursements from the Food & Nutrition program!

Guests may join us for lunch by calling the office before 9:00 a.m. the day of to make a reservation. Guest meals are \$4.00 for adults and \$2.00 for children, cash or check. Please stop by the office before the meal to pay.

You can put any amount on your child's lunch account, preferably at least a month's worth. We need each family to sign up for lunch notifications in Powerschool in August; instructions online & in enrollment fliers.

All lunch checks should be made out to HFE Cafe, and please indicate in the memo that it is for lunch with the amount desired for each child. **Meal payments must always remain *separate* from all other school payments!
